



Cholesterol, triglyceride and glucose screenings are available to 3i Show attendees daily from 9 a.m. to noon and require an 8-hour fast to be accurate. Finally, oral cancer screenings will be offered each afternoon from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

All health services are free of charge, although donations will be accepted.

Northwest Kansas Technical College offers new technology, programs and online classes

New GPS/GIS equipment and a motion-capture 3-D animation system are two new technologies now available at Northwest Kansas Technical College in Goodland.

In January, NWKTC acquired the latest Global Positioning System (GPS)/Geographic Information System (GIS) technology for the Engineering Technology Program. The equipment was purchased from a federal Carl Perkins grant for \$55,155.

The new technology includes surveying equipment, a mapping database system, two 30-inch computer monitors, two laptop computers and enhanced computer hardware.

The equipment will be used to teach students how to survey land using satellites and create maps, which are skills needed in the fields of infrastructure design and public health planning, among others.

The acquisition is a result of a joint effort between NWKTC President Kenneth A. Clouse and the Kansas Society of Land Surveyors to find ways to replenish the diminishing pool of licensed surveyors.

NWKTC has also added a Motion Capture system for 3-D computer animation to its Computer Graphics Technology Program. The acquisition is a result of a Kansas Board of Regents Innovative Technology Grant in the amount of \$5,000 and a matching \$5,000 equipment donation from Denver-based Fineline Signs and Graphics.

Motion Capture is a technique of digitally recording movements for entertainment,

sports or medical applications. A performer wears markers near each joint to identify and track their motions. Computer software records the motion and turns it into 3-D animation. The Motion Capture system will be used to teach basic and advanced principals of animation.

New welding and respiratory therapy programs

In addition to new technology, Northwest Kansas Technical College has also added two new programs. They are:

—Welding Pipe/Plate Specialist. This is an 18-week program that, once completed, allows students to provide welding services for new ethanol plants and many other applications.

—Respiratory Therapy. A one or two year program that enables students to earn a certified respiratory therapy credentials. Employment of respiratory therapists is expected to increase faster than the average for all occupations through the year 2010.

Additional online classes offered for fall 2008

Recently acquired Angel Online Learning software has enabled NWKTC to expand its online learning program. In addition to the current online classes available in our Telecommunications Network Analyst, Communications Technology and Business Technology programs, online classes in most of our programs will be available in the fall of 2008.

A Kansas Board of Regents Technology and Equipment Grant awarded in January

enabled the college to purchase the online learning platform.

New degree offering

This is the first school year that NWKTC offers all the classes needed for a student to earn an Associates of Applied Science degree.

In fall 2007, NWKTC began offering Technical Math, Ethics in the Workplace, and Human Relations for Life and Work in addition to the Technical Writing and Computer Fundamentals and Applications classes that were first offered last year to fulfill general education requirements for a college degree.

Students now have the option of a one-year program in which they can earn a technical certificate or they may take the additional general education classes in a two-year program in order to earn an associate's degree.

Northwest Kansas Technical College confers technical certificates and Associates of Applied Science degrees in 18 programs. More than 250 students attend the technical and general education classes offered at NWKTC. Northwest Kansas Technical College was established in 1964 as a public area vocational technical school by the Kansas State Department of Education. The school received its status as a college in 2001 and is currently governed by the Kansas Board of Regents. Northwest Kansas Technical College is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, one of six regional institutional accreditors in the United States. ♦

2. Lease alternative pastureland
3. Pay leases when herds have been culled to very low levels
4. Restock herds once the drought is over

The programs are available in

only certain states and counties, and the majority of the cost is paid by the USDA. Producers have until November 30 to purchase insurance for the 2008 crop year.





Future of oilseed processing is now

Plains Oilseed Products Cooperative (POP), formed recently and Producers Cooperative Oil Mill (PCOM), formed in 1944, have signed an agreement to jointly promote and crush oilseed (canola, sunflower and other oilseed). The facility will produce oil to be used in both the food industry and in the production of biofuels.

The unusual alliance of agriculture producers—an oilseed crusher, state universities, a national seed supplier and American Farmers and Ranchers Mutual Insurance Company (Oklahoma Farmers Union)—is announcing a novel investment to provide agriculture producers in the Southern Great Plains with a new market for current and future oilseed crops. POP will be farmer-owned, making producers a part of the value-added co-op to enhance their profitability. The alliance will also add to the economic development of rural America.

This project has had the help of many agriculture and industry leaders and producers, including Oklahoma Farmers Union, Monsanto Dekalb Genetics, United States Department of Agriculture, Plains Oilseed Products, Producers Cooperative Oil Mill, Monsanto Company, Oklahoma State University and the Oklahoma Department

of Agriculture, Food and Forestry.

As a result of this alliance, Southern Great Plains wheat farmers gained significant benefits in several ways from growing canola, an oilseed adapted to the southern growing region. Research teams from both Oklahoma State University and Kansas State University worked very hard over six years, to develop an understanding of the value and yield of winter canola.

Rotating Roundup Ready winter canola with wheat crops will give farmers the benefit of better weed control and increased yields. The canola producers will have marketing contracts to know what their oilseed is worth before planting time. The newly retrofitted oilseed crushing plant in Oklahoma City will have several local delivery points throughout the Southern Great Plains, saving on transportation costs of delivery of the oilseed to more northern markets.

Producers Cooperative Oil Mill also announced that it will start crushing NuSun sunflowers in the fall of 2008. This crop will give producers a spring planted crop for rotation.

PCOM will retrofit current cottonseed crushing capacity to allow additional capacity and infrastruc-

ture for crushing winter canola and sunflowers for oil to be used in the food industry and biofuel production. POP will continue to work with grain handlers across the Southern Great Plains to establish additional local delivery points for growers' oilseed.

Oklahoma Farmers and Ranchers Energy Enterprise (OKFREE), formed by Oklahoma Farmers Union, gained early value through a USDA value-added grant to study the feasibility of processing oilseed and understand the key market opportunities for producers' oilseed to be used in the food industry and biofuels industry. OKFREE also invested funds and in-kind contributions to ensure producers would have a facility that could contract to crush oilseeds and produce the final products. Also POP received a Value Added Cooperative Marketing Loan from the Ag Enhancement Diversification Program, a division of the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry.

The investment—from seed to finished oil—in the Southern Great Plains is a key focus of many rural policy makers to help local producers become successfully diversified and grow a dynamic agriculture economy. ♦




